Investment focus

BB Biotech invests worldwide in fast growing companies developing and marketing innovative biotech drugs. At least 90% of its shareholdings must be in listed companies, while always holding more than 50% of its assets in equity investments. The target portfolio of BB Biotech will generally consist of 20 to 35 participations. Large positions will be taken in five to eight companies, the top holdings. Together they will account for no more than two-thirds of the portfolio and no single position will have a weighting greater than 25% of portfolio investments. Due to their substantial portfolio weighting, the top holdings should be generating both revenues and income. The portfolio's smaller participations are companies with promising drug candidates in their R&D pipelines. Investments are selected according to a thorough, multi-level due diligence process, with a particular focus placed on the analysis of financial parameters, the respective competitive environment, the development pipeline, the patent portfolio, and end-client perception. ESG factors are taken into consideration while implementing the aforementioned investment objectives.



Market commentary

In July BB Biotech's share price increased by 15.5% in CHF and the Net Asset Value increased by 1.6% in USD. The Nasdaq Biotech Index was up by 1.3% in USD in July.

BB Biotech reported its second quarter results on July 21 showing a net loss of CHF 13 mn, compared to a net loss of CHF 233 mn during the same period in 2022. During a relatively calm three-month period in terms of portfolio activity, the investment team executed minor reallocations within the portfolio. The generated cash enabled participation in a capital increase and extending of existing positions in open market transactions without increasing leverage. Please find below selected highlights from a few of BB Biotech's portfolio companies:

Argenx (+29.4%, in USD) announced on July 17 positive topline results from the ADHERE study evaluating Vyvgart Hytrulo (efgartigimod alfa and hyaluronidase-qvfc) in adults with chronic inflammatory demyelinating polyneuropathy (CIDP). The study met its primary endpoint (p=0.000039), demonstrating a significantly lower risk of relapse with Vyvgart Hytrulo compared to placebo. Detailed data from ADHERE will be presented at an upcoming medical meeting.

Alnylam (+2.9%, in USD) announced on July 24 it has entered into a strategic agreement with Roche to develop and commercialize zilebesiran, Alnylam's investigational RNAi therapeutic for the treatment of hypertension, which is currently in Phase II of development. The partnership allows for a bold development plan with the goal of disrupting the hypertension treatment paradigm globally while advancing Alnylam's P5x25 strategy.

Mersana Therapeutics (-62.8%, in USD) announced July 27 that the UPLIFT clinical trial of upifitamab rilsodotin (UpRi) did not meet its primary endpoint. UpRi is an ADC targeting the sodium-dependent phosphate transport protein NaPi2b and was developed utilizing the company's Dolaflexin platform. UPLIFT was a single-arm clinical trial that enrolled platinum-resistant ovarian cancer patients with one to four prior treatment regimens. **Outlook**

BB Biotech remains focused on value growth and is optimistic about fundamental progress achieved by innovative biotech companies in the large-, mid- and small-cap segments. We continue to believe that these companies are attractive investments.
